



Young Scientist Prize - SPM Tribute to Isabel Spencer-Martins is attributed by the Portuguese Society for Microbiology to award an outstanding young PhD researcher for his/her contribution in the field of *Yeast Biology*.

Rules & Eligibility:

The direction of the Portuguese Society for Microbiology (SPM) and the MicroBiotec'15 Organizing Committee consider eligible those candidates who have completed their Ph.D. in Biology of Yeasts during the years 2014 or 2015 or those whose Viva is scheduled for 2015. Awarding the Prize "Young Investigator" is based exclusively on the analysis of the curriculum vitae of the candidates. The selection criteria considers the scientific article (s) published, supported by the impact factor of the journal where the article (s) was (were) published, corrected by weighting authoring (1, if first or last author; 0.6, if second or penultimate; 0.3, if in any other position). In case of a tie, the first tiebreaker will be the number of book chapters, followed by the number of oral presentations at conferences.

How to apply:

Applications must be sent by e.mail to microbiotec15@uevora.pt with the words “Spencer-Martins award” in the Subject field. The following information should be submitted in a file attached to e.mail message:
